Since it's inception, Girl Talk has served more than 30,000 girls and their families.

Janine continues to exercise her commitment to girls and mentorship. She has passed the baton as a nonprofit leader to former Girl Talk participant Alyssa Shepard – who runs the organization.

JD is a community champion and award-winning radio personality. She's been recognized for her inspiring work with awards like "Best Radio Show of the Year" and "Radio Legends Award." Her commitment to serving her community extends beyond the airwaves, as evidenced by her published work, "JD's Inspirational Moments." Janine has been honored for her contributions to Charlotte.
